# TALISMANS OF THE KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

Known for both worldly treasure and esoteric knowledge, the Templar mythos transcends Time and Space to energise these compelling symbols.

## KT1 NEW ORDER OF THE AGES

It is believed that the secrets of the Knights Templar live on in occult societies that consider The Eye of Providence a symbol of illumination. *Securum Novus Ordo* is taken from a poem by Virgil, longing for peace and happiness. Its wearer may be guided to an **Enlightened and Happy Future.**

## KT2 NON NOBIS DOMINE

The Knights Templar stood for bravery and chivalry, *Non Nobis Domine* was their motto and counsels individual humility and compassion as glory is not for the self, it is for Higher Beings. The Templar sword, helmet and shield along with the legendary Templar motto may bring the wearer attributes of **Bravery, Chivalry and Selflessness.**

## KT3 TEMPLAR LION

The Templar cross surmounts the mother goddess crescent moon, the stars and the noble lion as image of Knight Templar's fierce determination and courage. Based on the seal of an English Master Templar, the wearer may be brought **Power and Success.**

## KT4 SHIELD CROSS

The Templar warrior's shield stands fast behind the cross of devotion, showing the world a formidable and invincible force, one which will extinguish the flaming arrows of evil and so is worn for **Protection from evil.**

## KT5 THE TWO RIDERS

This Templar Seal, widely used by French Templars and depicting Two Riders on a single horse symbolise the Templars' dual nature as warriors and monks. The wearer of The Two Riders is a True Seeker of **Brotherhood and Compassion.**

## KT6 BYZANTINE EAGLE

The eagle is an heraldic bird of the first order symbolising courage and determination. The double-headed eagle signifies a man of action, one of lofty spirit. Adopted by a Master Templar in mediaeval times and combined with the mythological all-seeing Eye of Providence, its wearer sees all and has an authority over re-birth and immortality. This design, both awesome and mysterious, may bring its wearer righteous **Power and Glory.**

## KT7 ROCHEFORT SEAL

Reproduced from the seal of Knights Templar Preceptor Hugh de Rochefort, the Cross, Star, and Fleur-de-Lys are enclosed in the mystic circle with no beginning and no end. The **Rochefort Seal** may bring its wearer **Good Fortune and Financial Acumen.**

## KT8 AGNUS DEI

The Pascal Lamb was a favoured Templar symbol of charity and chivalry, depicting the highest good that can be achieved through self-betterment. The symbol was used in the seals of many Knights Templar, in recognition of the blessings of knowledge and wisdom. It is worn for **Spiritual Knowledge and Wisdom.**

## KT9 JERUSALEM CROSS

The Knights Templar were so named from Jerusalem's ancient Solomon's Temple which became their headquarters in the 12th Century. The five crosses represent the Universal absolutes of Earth, Air, Fire, Water, and Spirit. The wearer of **Jerusalem Cross** is a True Seeker of **Worldly and Spiritual Riches.**

## KT10 TEMPLAR ANKH

It is believed that during their many crusading expeditions, the Templars were initiated into the mysteries of ancient Egypt and preserved those ancient symbols and ways, using this knowledge in secret magical ceremonies. The wearer of **Templar Ankh** is a True Seeker of **Self-Mastery and Immortality.**

## KT11 ENGRAILED CROSS

Celtic, Gnostic, and Templar themes feature in the Engrailed Cross found in mysterious mediaeval Rosslyn Chapel in Scotland. Reflecting the Templar view that tradition is worth preserving, this cross can be worn for putting order into the **Meaning of Life.**

## KT12 SOLAR CROSS

The solar cross symbol stands for the life-giving properties of the Sun and eternal light. The central Templar cross is surrounded by 4 further Templar crosses and quatrefoil, all signifying protection from illness. Its wearer may be given **Strong Health and Mental Vigour.**

## KT13 SIGIL OF ABRAXAS

An image of great antiquity, **Abraxas** was adopted by Templars as a powerful icon of their secret magical lore and was reproduced on certain seals. This seal from the Order's inner and secret sanctum may give its wearer **Magickal Right and Might.**

## KT14 BLADE AND CHALICE

In mediaeval times it was believed that the Knights Templar guarded the Holy Grail with their Templar swords. The invincible and perfect union, they come together to form the hexagram of Solomon's seal and represent too perfect balance and completeness, bringing the wearer **Perfect Love and Perfect Trust.**

## KT15 CONSECRATION CROSS

This traditional and sacred Templar cross has been discovered within secret shrines and on the graves of celebrated Knights Templar, sanctifying their resting places with respect and in celebration of their pure and noble status. The **Consecration Cross** may bring its wearer a sense of **Nobility and Higher Purpose.**

## KT16 TOMAR CROSS

Tomar is home to a Templar castle, an important site of mystical and spiritual irradiation, around which a town grew. The rare white cross set within a Templar cross of red, a design of elegant sophistication, was adopted and painted on the sails of their ships and so is worn for **Protection on Life's Journey.**
